DONJON SERVICES DEMOLISHES HISTORIC BOLMER BUILDING IN BOUND BROOK, NJ

Hillside, NJ – Donjon Services, the land demolition division of Donjon Marine, Co., Inc., a provider of multi-faceted marine services including marine salvage, heavy lift, dredging, recycling, demolition and related emergency response services, has demolished the Bolmer Building in Bound Brook, New Jersey. The contract was through the Borough of Bound Brook.

Built in 1912, The Bolmer Building started out as a car dealership. It was later purchased by the Borough of Bound Brook and used for Department of Public Works' offices and garages. After Hurricane Floyd and years of neglect, the borough decided to demolish the building. The cleared site will initially be used by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers as a staging area for materials and equipment for local flood gate projects. Its end use will be open space for the community.

Project Manager Ryan Walsh said, "The job went very smoothly and was an overall success. We completed the demolition phase of the project on time and without incident. We had fantastic support from the borough, which contributed to a successful project. Donjon was also able to recycle or divert 70% of the debris generated at the site."
